

# WESTBROOK.

The citizens of Westbrook are beginning to take an interest in the observance of Old Home Week, and on Thursday evening of the past week a meeting was held at which a number of the representative men of the city were in attendance and expressed favorable views on the idea of observing Westbrook day. An organization was perfected with Mayor J. L. Horr as president and city clerk, Edward H. Smith as secretary. It was decided to observe Thursday, August 9th, as Westbrook Day, and an effort will be made to secure as large an attendance of former Westbrook citizens upon the exercises of the occasion as possible. The program has not been definitely decided upon as yet, but will probably include a complimentary dinner to the former residents of Westbrook either at some hall or church, and in the evening public exercises at which music will be furnished and remarks made by present and former residents of the city. Another meeting of the association will be held next Wednesday evening at 7.30 o'clock.

The "Pine Tree Catholic," published in the interests of the Catholics of Maine, edited by Mr. John F. Sullivan of this city, and published by Messrs. Holmes & Haley of Westbrook, is to make its initial bow next Friday, the first number being a souvenir of Bishop Healy's silver jubilee.

The degrees of the order were conferred on a candidate, Saturday evening, by the members of Westbrook Commandery, United Order of the Golden Cross. Refreshments were served after the initiation.

Mr. Harry W.
