

# LEGENDRE'S BAT IN GIVES TIGERS VICTORY

HANOVER, N. H., Jan. 26.—A spectacular rush and a timely tip in by Legendre netted Princeton a one-point victory, 30 to 29, over Dartmouth in an Intercollegiate League basketball game here tonight. The Hanover five led the visitors all the way until the last ten minutes, when the Tigers uncorked a smashing come-back, against which the Green was powerless. Legendre knocked in the winning basket from a jump with Cullen, and the ball scarcely touched the floor before the timer's gun ended the contest.

Princeton was clearly outclassed during the first part of the game and the Green was ahead, 16-14, at the middle recess. At the opening of the second half Dartmouth rolled up twelve points while the visitors were held scoreless. Then Princeton started an avalanche of baskets, which just rushed over the Green as the game ended.

The Hanover men seemed dazed before the unexpected attack and tightened just too late to prevent the lucky loss. Opie and Jeffries played well throughout the game and were all around the court in the final minutes. Millar and Heep guarded closely until the final break, and Heep registered four two-pointers. Cullen was the stellar man of the contest in floor work.
