

MARKS FALL IN ARMORY TRACK

Four meet records fell and two were equaled in Saturday's second annual LHHS Key Club and Rec Department track and field events at the Armory, where Ernie Ashton of the Lewiston Rec AC accounted for a double in junior-open running competitions. Ashton won the dash and the 240 yard run.

Marks tumbled in three age-group events in the accompanying contests presented under sanction of the State AAU. One of the brighter performances of the day from a Lewiston standpoint was the 44 foot, 10 inch shot put by Jim Lavoie of LHHS, representing the Recreation AC, bettering the school record of 42-7½, which he holds.
