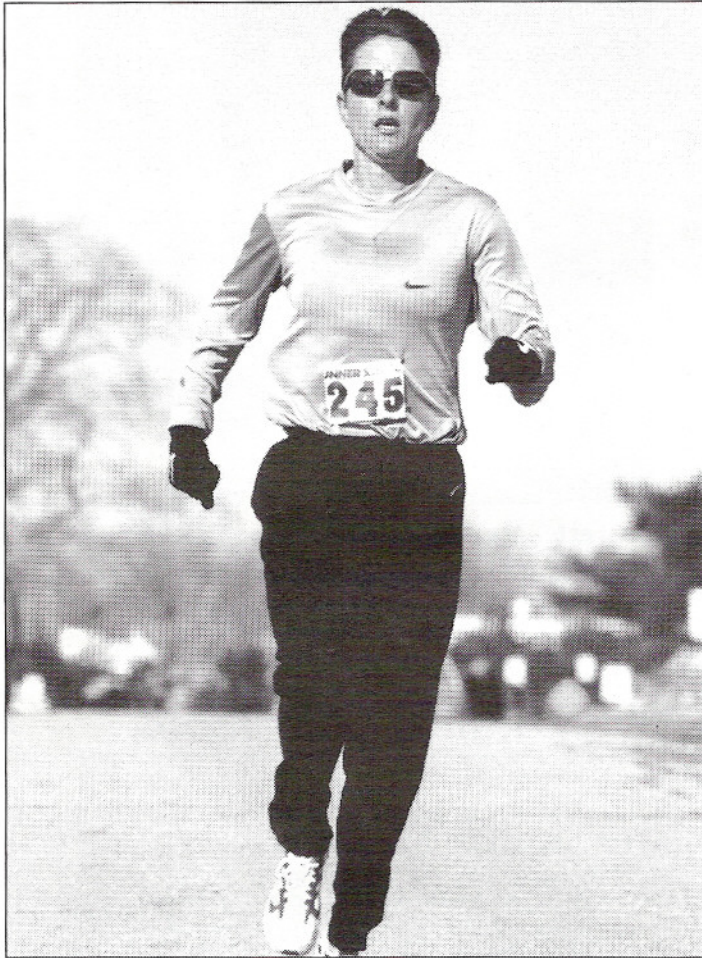

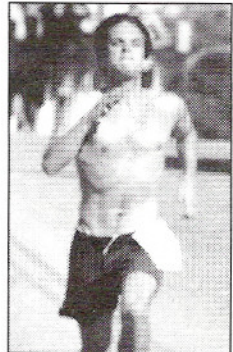


March MTC Meeting

Congratulations, Everett

For several years now, Everett Moulton has been one of the backbones of the MTC through his role as race committee chairman. At last month's MTC awards banquet, Everett was presented with an RRCA National Volunteer Award for his countless hours of work to support Maine running. Everett, who is now in his second year as RRCA's state representative for Maine, learned soon thereafter that he also has been named outstanding RRCA state rep for the Eastern region. That makes him one of four finalists for national state representative of the year, an award that will be announced at the annual RRCA convention from June 18-20 in Peoria, Ill.

Daniels to speak in South Portland

Jack Daniels, head cross country coach at SUNY-Cortland and one of the world's foremost experts on running, will be in South Portland to give a talk about road racing on Saturday, March 21, at 1:15 p.m. at the Sheraton Tara. The lecture is part of the Maine Track and Cross Country Coaches Association Clinic being held that weekend. There is a \$5 fee for the talk, which is open to anyone.
