1992 PEAKS ISLAND 5 MILER

The 5th Annual Peaks Island 5 Miler was held on Saturday, August 1st. The certified 5 mile course winds its way along the scenic shore line and through the hilly interior of the island.

This year's race was the most eventful and successful in the 5 year history of the event. A kids race, raffle and race incentives were added to the usual schedule that includes the 5 mile race, awards ceremony and tasty lobster feed put on by the Peaks Island Lion's Club.
