Many thanks for your response to our request for results on the "Mid-Winter 10 Mile Classic" which several Striders took part in.



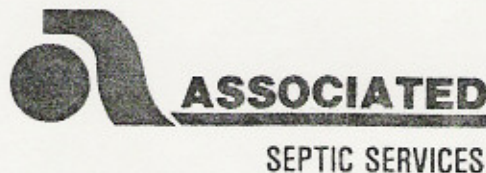
