Calling all festive folks who love the holidays - please plan on attending the 2nd Annual "Jingle Mel Run" in honor of our jolly ol' president, Mel.


This is a very fun event in which club members gather together for a fun run along the Portland Trail to admire the holiday lights and to spread some holiday cheer.
