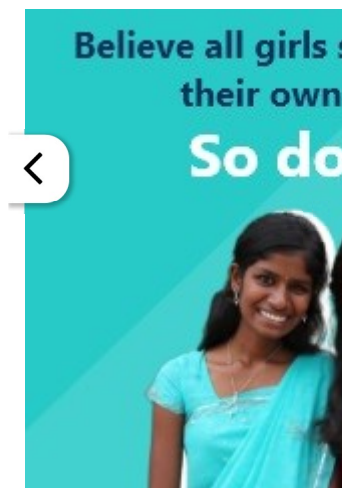
HOULTON, Maine — A small group of hardy runners and walkers turned out Saturday morning for the annual Wild Katahdin Trust Snow Run 5K road race.

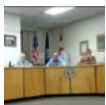
