

GREAT FOOT RACE.—On Thursday last a six mile foot race, two mile heats, took place at Bangor, Maine, between John Grindell, of N. York, an English pedestrian; named Cook, and five Indians, for a purse of \$100. Grindell won each heat; notwithstanding a fresh Indian was put upon the course at the commencement of each mile. Grindell made the following time:—1st mile 5 10; 2d 5 20; 3d 5 12; 4th 5 32; 5th 5 15; and 6th 5 17. Total 31m. 40s. About 15,000 persons were on hand to witness the proceedings.
