

No replays at Penquis Relays

Tough times invade track boys

 For Foxcroft Academy Greenville and PCHS track squads, the 1975 Penquis Relays at Dexter High School last Friday was no ordinary year. The Ponies lacked the weightmen the Lakers were minus the sprinters, and the Pirates fought a personal shortage as the Warriors of Nokomis squeezed past the host Tigers 147-143 to dethrone the Bengals as defending Relay champions.

It was a marvelous Friday afternoon for FA's Randy King, who despite not recording a first place in the meet, was runner-up behind Lincoln's Dick Cole for top scorer on the afternoon. The junior jumper sprinter leaped to a third in the triple jump and fourth in the long jump and 440 yard dash for 14 points plus being a member of the Ponies third place relay team. Greenville's Mark Muzzy also was a three-time placer in the Penquis Relays. The standout senior athlete muscled a third in the shot put, fourth in the discus and a sixth in the javelin for Coach Barney Keenan.

Foxcroft's Mike Goum was a repeat performer for the Ponies. He ran a fourth in the 180 low hurdles which had to be a disappointment for Goum as he was the defending champ in the event with a Penquis Relay record time a year ago. Goum also sped to a fifth in the 100 yard dash. Laker Jim Bourgoine was the shot put behind Lincoln's Cole to take the fourth place team finish. Pony Steve Mountford ran his best time ever in the 880 but had to settle for second place behind Dexter's superlative Randy Hills.

For the Pirates of Coach Rusty Sweeney, Marc Holland and Terry Priest placed discus and time run respectively. The Pirates entered only four individuals in the Penquis meet.
