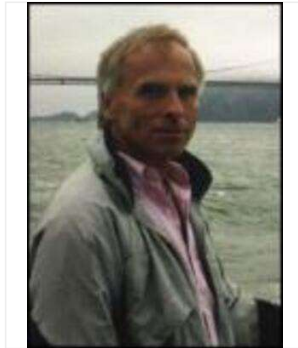


Erik Seastead
